# CURRENT STATUS

- 1.5 Million Engineering Students / Year Graduate in India
- No UNISEC in India / Algeria
- Space activities mainly pursued by Government with very limited participation of universities
- 5 university satellites flown in India
- No international cooperation in space at university level

# PROBLEMS

- Limited space education department in the universities
- No consensus to work together
- No direct funding from space agency
- Quality professors / infrastructure

# MERIT FOR UNISEC

- University cooperation nationally and internationally
- Faculty & student exchange (nationally and internationally)
- Applying for a joint national/international funding
- Creation of space relevant infrastructure

# FIRST STEPS

- Create consensus with 2-3 universities to form Chapter
- Short event - SpaceUp to bind relationship
- Identify a national mission with university contribution
- CanSat National Competition

# ROADMAP

- Make a joint funding applications
- Coordination between Space Agency - University for turnkey missions for global societal benefits
- Add to Ground Station Network (GSN)
