Here is a procedure (as of October 18).

- 0) Participants read Group Discussion Topics and understand all groups.

- 1) Each moderator has a chance of 5 minutes presentation to introduce each group (what will be discussed, who should attend, how the group is organized, and what outcome is expected, etc.)
- 2) All participants decide which group they join.
- 3) Assistants (The University of Tokyo students assigned for each group) hold a paper that each group number is written, and participants go to the group.
- 4) All groups will go to designated room with help of assistants (After Group lunch).
- 5) Start discussion (the way of organizing the discussion depends on the moderator.)
- 6) Come back to the exhibition hall in the afternoon break, and then go back to Koshiba Hall (main conference hall).
- 7) Final presentations are made by all groups in front of all participants on the final day of the meeting.
